Saturday 11 th October 2008	Cutting and piecing of blocks for actual quilt
Saturday 8 th November 2008	Assembly of quilts, borders, choice of quilting designs and marking
Saturday 10 th January 2009	Basting quilts ready to quilt, basics of machine quilting
Saturday 14 th February 2009	Quilting, binding and labeling

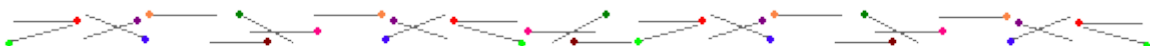
Class Requirements

(Please remember that we have fabric and equipment in the workshop that you can buy/borrow)

- Rotary Cutter, cutting mat and ruler (6x24")
- Sewing machine, oiled and cleaned, good working order, threaded with a neutral grey or beige thread. Please bring the instruction book if you have it, also all the feet that you have for it.
- Masking tape (from the DIY shop, not a special quilting gadget)
- Pencil and paper
- Material: 0.5m of dark fabric, 0.5 of light fabric.
- Basic sewing kit - scissors, unpicker, pins, spare machine needles etc., electric extension cord.
- Fabric: the pattern and colour are not important, we are learning how to rotary cut and machine piece the first day and not making your quilt. As long as there is a good contrast between the two fabrics they will be fine. On the day we will talk about the size quilt that you wish to make over the five months and discuss colour choices and amounts to buy.
- If you have extra rotary cutting rulers, please bring them. A 6" square and a 12 x 6" ruler will be particularly useful if you have them. Please don't buy any extra rulers for the course yet, the 6x24" will meet all your needs for the first class and you can then decide which others, if any, to buy before the next class!
