Dressmaking with Sandra from Calico Fabrics

Learn to make a pretty lined A line skirt which sits on or just above the knee for best effect.

This workshop assumes NO prior dressmaking knowledge, although someone who has made clothes in the past may enjoy it as it is a project that encourages creativity.

You will learn how to cut out a pattern, transfer markings, make darts and seams, insert a lapped zip and work an invisible hem.

It is fun to think of new ways to embellish and really wow it up and it is great for summer with a simple top.



Sandra has been teaching dressmaking classes and some associated workshops for the last four years. She encourages you to work to the highest standard you are able, but is also very patient and likes to encourage creativity.

Running classes from her shop, Calico, Sandra tends to know where the trends in fashion and dressmaking are going. Prior to this she spent five years in wardrobe at the Watermill Theatre, and gained her initial experience working for John Lewis for eleven years, mostly with dress fabrics. In short, Sandra has spent most of her working life in and around textiles.

Make a hanging with a Valentine heart appliquéd onto a log cabin background.

The log cabin block is an old favourite and beginners are always amazed at how easy it is to make.

Traditionally the centre square is always red to represent hearth and home, but in this design Sandra Kidwell has put a country-style heart in the middle – perhaps with St Valentine's Day in mind!

Because the block is so versatile, and quick to make, you may decide to make a quilt in the same pattern.
